COVID-19 Update: City of Monterey Park Extends Suspension of Indoor Library and Recreation Dept. Services Until Further Notice

Monterey Park, Calif. - January 27, 2022 –

Due to the current transmission rate of COVID-19, the City of Monterey Park will extend the closure of Library and Recreation Department buildings until further notice in order to maintain public health and safety operations. The City will re-evaluate the situation over the next weeks to determine how best to update operations, public engagement and programs.

Monterey Park City Hall will remain open by appointment only and outdoor activities and programming will continue to be permissible with the recommendation that all persons wear a mask at crowded/dense outdoor events and while in line to enter, exit, use the bathroom, etc.

Various Monterey Park Bruggemeyer Library services such as contactless checkout, outdoor storytime and outdoor expanded pop-up services will continue to be offered. For more information, please contact the library at 626-307-1366, or visit the Library's [website](#).
