



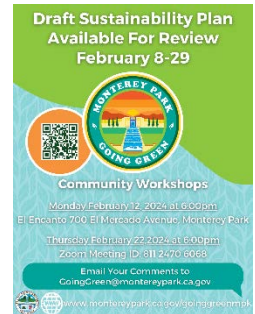

Monterey Park, Calif. — February 8, 2024 — The City of Monterey Park Draft Sustainability Plan is open for review and comments through 5:00 p.m., February 29, 2024.
