



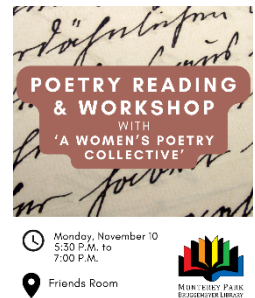

A Feast of Poetry at Monterey Park Bruggemeyer Library

Monterey Park, Calif. — October 23, 2025 — Aspiring poets are invited to a poetry workshop and reading of “An Illegal Feast,” the newly-released collaborative poetry collection by Addison, Flores, Goyan, King and Wong, an invitation-only women’s poetry collective. The program will be held on Monday, November 10 from 5:30 to 7 p.m. in the Monterey Park Bruggemeyer Library Friends Room.
