Los Angeles County Extends Curfew Through Monday, June 1 From 6 p.m.-6 a.m.

Monterey Park, Calif. - June 1, 2020 - LA County has extended a countywide curfew within the unincorporated and incorporated areas of Los Angeles County through tonight, Monday, June 1, 2020 from 6:00 p.m.-6:00 a.m.

“I would like to thank the Monterey Park community for their concern for safety and reassure everyone that there has been no civil unrest in the City at this time,” said Monterey Park City Manager Ron Bow. “The Monterey Park Police Department continues to monitor and reassess the situation in an effort to maintain law and order. For your safety and the safety of our community, I encourage all residents to adhere to the countywide curfew.”

The City of Monterey Park will follow the County of Los Angeles (<https://lacounty.gov/emergency/>) in imposing the citywide curfew from 6:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. to ensure public safety across our region. Emergency responders are exempt, as are those traveling to and from work or seeking or giving emergency care.
