The project includes the addition of bike lanes, -pedestrian mobility improvements including sidewalks and ADA ramps, paving and striping, and related improvements. The project includes traffic signal improvements at Potrero Grande and Markland and at Market Place. These improvements have been completed. The project is funded by LA Metro under Mat Cycle 1.
