



An Accessory Dwelling Unit (ADU) and Junior Accessory Dwelling Unit (JADU) are each a **secondary** residential dwelling unit that provide complete independent living facilities and are located on a lot with a proposed or existing primary residence. Each shall include permanent provisions for living, sleeping, eating, cooking, and sanitation on the same parcel as the primary residence.

ADUs and JADUs are regulated by Monterey Park Municipal Code Chapter 21.50 and California Government Code §66310-66342.

²Converted ADUs must be solely converted. Garages may be converted and expanded upon up to 150 sqft accommodating ingress/egress per [GOV §66323\(a\),\(1\)\(A\)](#).

³Per [GOV §66321\(b\),\(4\)](#), for Detached ADU only, increase max height to 18ft if the detached ADU is:

- a) “within a half-mile walking distance of a [major transit stop](#) or a [high-quality transit corridor](#).” An additional two feet in height is allowed to accommodate a roof pitch on the accessory dwelling unit that is aligned with the roof pitch of the primary dwelling unit when the pitch must match; or
- b) “on a lot with an existing or proposed multifamily, multistory dwelling.”

Owner-Occupancy	Requires owner-occupancy in the primary residence or JADU if the JADU does not have its own bathroom.	Not required		
Short Term Rental	Short-term rental of ADU or JADU is prohibited. Planning requires a Covenant as part of “planning clearance”.
