My name is Minh Huynh and my pronouns are he/him. I'm a Research VolunQueer at the SGV LGBTQ Center and a resident of the city of San Gabriel. I am here today to support the proclamation from the SGV TGI Wellness and Justice Team of the Dr. Solis Policy Institute. TGI residents in the SGV depend on the support from our local governments when left against the hate and violence in our current administration. By having our cities stand besides our TGI residents, it recognizes the existence of trans identities and takes against the active erasure that is happening amongst our communities. I ask Monterey Park's City Council to not only take a stand with our TGI community, but to acknowledge and be in the presence of the pain that many TGI individuals are burdened with. To help trans people feel that they can imagine what tomorrow can be, it starts with our local governments by understanding the weight of what it means to be trans today. This brings in the value of what our local cities need to provide the necessities for TGI people and for communities to come together to build towards the vision of what an accepting future for TGI individuals would look like. To declare November 20th as Transgender Day of Remembrance, we commemorate the many lives who could no longer bear to exist in times that don't recognize the existence of TGI people and the

many who were faced by the cruel violence and hatred that reflects these times. For many TGI individuals, they ask to be seen and understood within these critical moments and a day for those we have lost to rest. I urge Monterey Park's City Council to take a stand against anti-transgender hate and to take a stand with our TGI community for us to hold this moment to remember the TGI lives that were taken away. Re: 1977 Saturn Data Center Project – Hearing Continuance Request for Agenda Item 10.A

Dear Honorable City Council,

We represent HMC StratCap 1977 Saturn, LLC (“Applicant”) regarding its data center project (“Project”) located at 1977 Saturn Street in the City of Monterey Park (“City”). The City Council is scheduled to consider the Project at its November 19, 2025 hearing as Item 10.A on the agenda. On behalf of the Applicant, we respectfully **request a continuance of Item 10.A to the next regularly-scheduled City Council meeting on December 3, 2025**, for the following reasons.

Importantly, we understand that Councilmember Vinh T. Ngo will be absent from the November 19, 2025 hearing. The Project is in Councilmember Ngo’s district. In order to ensure that Councilmember Ngo has an adequate opportunity to consider the Project, the Applicant request that the City continue Item 10.A to the next regularly scheduled City Council hearing date.

In addition, we recognize that other members of the City Council, and the public, may benefit from additional time to consider the staff report and attached materials issued on November 14, 2025. The Applicant encourages and supports full consideration of the administrative record by the councilmembers before deliberating on the Project. Thus, a continuance until December 3, 2025 facilitates further informed decision making.

In closing, the Applicant appreciates the City’s responsiveness and good efforts to prepare the Project for public hearing. We will appear at the November 19, 2025 hearing to reiterate our request for a continuance. Nonetheless, please provide this letter to City staff and the councilmembers at your earliest opportunity so they are timely informed of the Applicant’s request for a continuance.
