Purpose:

The Monterey Park Bruggemeyer Library Board of Trustees believes that the exterior of the library needs to be aesthetically pleasing to the patrons who use the library.

Provisions:

The only signage that may be placed on the exterior of the library and the grounds of the library are signs that the Library has generated or that are needed to control traffic.

Library-generated signs are those that state changes to the daily operations of the library such as holiday closures, emergency power interruptions, excessive capacity of patrons in the building, or any other incident which will impact the daily operations and services of the library.

Informational signage shall only be placed on the front and back entrance doors and at no other location on the building.
